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Video Competition - Conditions Of Entry

1. Entry to the *Rights, Camera, Action* Video Competition is free and opens at 9.00am CST on **Monday 1 February 2010**. Any cost associated with accessing the promotional websites is the entrant's responsibility and is dependent on the Internet service provider used.
2. Each entry must be submitted in digital format on CD or DVD at the highest quality possible, and be no longer than two and a half minutes long. Each entry must include a completed official entry form. Instructions on how to enter the competition are also available on-line at www.safework.sa.gov.au/youth, www.eoc.sa.gov.au, and www.passporttosafety.com/australia. This document, the instructions on how to enter the Competition and any other details about the competition all form part of the terms and conditions of entry.
3. Entry for the *Rights, Camera, Action* Video Competition is open to all South Australian school students.
4. All entrants under 18 years of age must obtain the prior permission of a parent or legal guardian to:
 - a. Submit an entry in the *Rights, Camera, Action* Video Competition; and
 - b. use and publish an entry as set out in paragraph 18 below.
5. This competition is not open to sponsors or those representing an organisation on the judging panel.
6. A separate entry form must accompany each entry.
7. Entries must be received by **5pm CST on Friday, 1 October 2010**. For reasons of fairness, late entries will not be accepted.
8. Competition winners will be announced on the *Passport to Safety*, SafeWork SA and Equal Opportunity Commission websites in October 2010.
9. The judges will determine one winner and two runners up. Each complete entry will be individually judged based on originality, creativity and impact of the message.
10. Judges will have complete discretion in assessing entries, applying the judging criteria, conditions of entry and determining the winners of the Competition.
11. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
12. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash. No responsibility is accepted for any variation in the number or value of the prizes. The Promoter will not be responsible if the prizes or any part of the prizes become unavailable for reasons beyond the Promoter's control.
